**Wednesday, June 8**

**Depart the US**

Depart the US or Canada today. Flights can be booked through Borton Overseas.

**Thursday, June 9 Arrive Copenhagen**

**D (lite evening meal)**

Independent arrivals today to Copenhagen. Upon arrival you will have a transfer booked to your hotel. Rest of day free to explore. Meet your guide this evening. Have a lite evening buffet served in the hotel between 6-9 pm. *Overnight Clarion Neptun Hotel*

**Friday, June 10 Tour of Copenhagen**

**B D (lite evening meal)**

This morning have a tour of Copenhagen. Your English speaking guide will show you some of the capitals best highlights. Visit Nyhavn (harbor area), Amalienborg Palace and also the see the Little Mermaid. Transfer to the National Museum of Denmark this morning for your private tour of the Museum. Afternoon free to explore. *Overnight Clarion Neptun hotel*

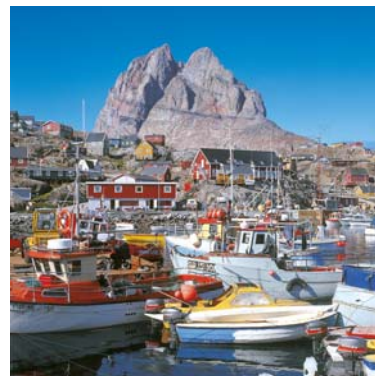
**Saturday, June 11 Free day in Copenhagen**

**B D**

Day free to explore with your Copenhagen city card. This evening have a group dinner at the hotel along with a Greenlandic speaker. *Overnight Clarion Neptun*

**Sunday, June 12 Depart for Greenland B D**

Fly from Copenhagen to Kangerlussuaq, our main gateway into Greenland. Consisting of less than 600 hardy souls, who live and work in this remote desert-like landscape, the settlement is situated close to the majestic inland ice sheet that covers more than 80% of the country. *Overnight onboard the MS Fram for the next 7 nights*



**Monday, June 13****Sisimiut****B L D**

The second largest community in Greenland, Sisimiut's bounty comes from the sea, with a modern fishing fleet, a shipyard and a fish processing factory all contributing to the town's prosperity. We recommend a visit to the local Arts and Crafts workshop close to the pier, where you can watch artisans create traditional jewelry and perhaps purchase a local souvenir or two.

**Tuesday, June 14****Qeqertarsuaq****B L D**

Situated on the old volcanic island of Disko, Qeqertarsuaq is home to an Arctic research station that is part of a Copenhagen University study into flora and fauna. You can spend the time here strolling along the beach, enjoying the spectacle of towering icebergs that lie grounded on the shore, or you might like to join a highly recommended walking tour to Blæsedalen, a place rich in Arctic flora.

**Wednesday, June 15****Uummannaq/Ukkusissat****B L D**

The town of Uummannaq is situated among a scenic landscape that lies at the foot of a 3,800 ft tall, heart-shaped mountain. You can join a walking tour of the area, or just stroll around this beautiful town taking in its genteel ambience at your own pace. We will be calling into Ukkusissat later this evening, a traditional settlement of less than 200 people which continues to survive on the riches harvested from hunting and fishing.

**Thursday, June 16****Eqip Sermia****B L D**

Three miles long and constantly calving off icebergs, the glacier front of Eqip Sermia is one of nature's most impressive creations and one of the best opportunities that you will ever have to truly appreciate the sheer majesty of the natural world.

**Friday, June 17****Ilulissat****B L D**

Ilulissat means iceberg in Greenlandic and this is a town that certainly lives up to its name. Sermeq Kujalleq is the most productive glacier in the northern hemisphere, feeding enormous icebergs into the Icefjord. Little wonder then that this stunning setting is on the UNESCO World Heritage list.



**Saturday, June 18****Itilleq****B L D**

Small and isolated, with only around 130 inhabitants, Itilleq is close to the Arctic Circle. Existing on hunting and fishing, the local community provides you with a rare insight into Greenlandic culture and life amongst these harsh and unforgiving landscapes.

**Sunday, June 19****Kangerlussuaq****B**

During the early 1960s, 27 musk oxen were introduced into Kangerlussuaq from northeastern Greenland. Today those herds number over 10,000. You have some time to explore the area more closely today before your overnight flight back to Copenhagen.

**Monday, June 20****Copenhagen****B D**

Upon arrival to Copenhagen early this morning, transfer to your hotel downtown. Have a special farewell dinner this evening at Skt. Gertruds Kloster. *Overnight Clarion Neptun*

**Tuesday, June 21****Copenhagen - Home****B**

Today, private transfers to the airport to meet your transatlantic flights home, or extend your stay in Scandinavia
