

CRUISE TO GREENLAND JUNE 2011 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TRAVEL DOCUMENTATION

A U.S. Citizen must be in possession of a valid passport with not less than six months validity remaining. Non-US Citizens should consult the appropriate consulates or call your travel agent for assistance.

PRICES

Prices are based on exchange rates at that time and are subject to change without notice. Prices are based on guaranteed, advanced bookings at Borton Overseas' contract rate with each supplier (i.e. hotels); seasonal and occupancy variations may occur. Borton Overseas is not responsible for any such price variance. The quoted cost represents a complete package price and an itemization of individual components cost will not be rendered. The right is reserved to substitute hotel property and location when necessary due to availability, from those described in the brochure.

CHANGES & CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations must be submitted in writing to Borton Overseas. A full refund less \$100 per person administrative fee will apply if cancellation is received on or before December 23, 2010. From December 24, 2010-March 16, 2011, the deposit is non-refundable. On or after March 17, 2011 there is no refund.

If Borton Overseas books your Transatlantic airline ticket from your home city: **Airline tickets have their own cancellation and change penalties; all of the above fees are in addition to any airline enforced cancellation fees or other unrecoverable fees from suppliers. No refund can be made for any tour accommodation, services or feature that the traveler does not utilize or voluntarily changes ; if you cancel while tour is in progress, there will be no refund for unused portions.**

TRIP INSURANCE

Borton Overseas will require travel insurance to protect you against loss due to cancellation, illness or accident on this tour. Please specify on this form (page 3) if you wish to purchase the coverage type. Borton Overseas will require the minimum trip insurance and proof of coverage in able to be a participant on this tour. Other travel insurance options also exist.

BAGGAGE

FREQUENT FLYER NUMBERS
